Second Amendment Protection Act (SAPA) rewrites the firearms laws of Georgia.

- It removes conflicting, confusing and overly restrictive laws.
- It includes the Car Carry Bill from the 2007 session.
- It stops capers like Mayor Bloomberg's straw purchasers.
- It repeals the Public Gathering law.
- It requires timely issuance of firearms licenses.
- It includes the Katrina Bill.

**Do you have a Georgia Firearms License (GFL)?
Law abiding citizens with a GFL,
It is currently illegal to carry (concealed or open carry)
in a restaurant that sells alcohol.**

There is a penalty of 20 years in prison for carrying near a MARTA bus stop.

There are currently several park bans.

Georgia has more places off limits to carry than any state in the nation.
